3. Why should I pledge if I already give regularly to the church?

For many of us, giving during the Offertory is a key moment in our worship experience, and that doesn't need to change. A pledge simply gives St. Paul's vestry an estimate-in-advance of what you intend to put in the offering plate for the year. Having that estimate ahead of time enables the vestry to plan and to make a responsible budget. You also may choose to give online or automate your giving through your bank, and still complete the act of giving in worship by putting an "I gave online" card into the offering plate.

4. What if my life situation changes and I can't afford my pledge?

Everyone at St. Paul's understands the uncertainties of life. If your financial situation changes, we understand that your financial support for St. Paul's may need to change as well. In fact, St. Paul's has a long history of mutual support for our members. We stand ready to help in times of need.

5. I can't be a "real" member of St. Paul's if I don't pledge.

Not true. Over the entrance to our church are painted three very important words: All Are Welcome. There are no membership dues required, no password needed, and no secret handshake. All who worship with us are members of the Body of Christ, and thus members of St. Paul's. Your pledge is simply your personal commitment to our Christian mission, and a sign of our collective gratitude.
